### VOTING PLACES REGULAR POLL

Voting places will be open for voting on Wednesday the 8th day of May, 2024 between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at the Golden Leisure Club, located at 30 Pine St, Pine Falls.

**IDENTIFICATION MAY BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO VOTE.** A person may be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (for example - driver's license or passport) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

### ADVANCE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they will be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on election day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at Town of Powerview-Pine Falls Municipal Office, located at 277B Main St, rear entrance and will be open during the following day, Saturday, April 27, 2024 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

### MOBILE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but reside at a health care facility, a mobile voting station will be set up at the following health care facilities on May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024 and will be open during the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 NOON.

### APPLICATION TO VOTE BY SEALED ENVELOPE

A voter who is unable to go in person to the voting place or vote in advance, may apply in person, in writing, or by e-mail to the senior election official at the Town Office at 277B Main Street, Powerview, email: [municipalsolutions@mts.net](mailto:municipalsolutions@mts.net)

If applying in person\*, a voter may apply between April 10, 2024 to May 5,2024.

\* A voter applying in person may pick up a sealed envelope ballot package at the time of application.

If applying by mail or e-mail\*\*, a voter may apply between March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2024 and May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024

\*\* A voter applying by mail or email will receive a sealed envelope ballot package by regular post, unless the application is received less than 12 days before the election in which alternative arrangements will be made with the senior election official.
